



Long-term Fellowships on the social, environmental and behavioural determinants of non-communicable diseases (NCDs) in Bangladesh

Goal

The aim is to create advanced sustainable capacity on NCD research in Bangladesh by providing long-term training in the UK and Bangladesh. It is anticipated that at least 8 such fellows from Bangladesh will be selected commencing in September 2018. These fellows will be a part of the CAPABLE programme and will research on specific themes. Each fellow will be co-supervised by a UK and Bangladesh mentor.

The fellowships will be based on i) Air Quality, ii) Environmental statistics, iii) Water and Arsenic, iv) Social Science and Gender Studies, v) Lifestyle factors (2 fellows), vi) NCD Epidemiology, vii) Behavioural Science and Pragmatic Trials.

Selection

The long-term Fellows will be selected from those who attended the Advanced short course on chronic non-communicable disease epidemiology. Selection will be based on performance during the course, qualifications and experience in a specific research theme.

Duration

The duration of the Fellowship will be up to 18 months. Each Fellow will generally spend between 3 and 12 months at a UK partner's institute (e.g. Cambridge) and the remainder of the time at one of the four Bangladeshi partner institutes.

Salary

All Fellows will be full time and will receive an appropriate monthly remuneration with other benefits.
